An extension for the recently built New Century Global Centre - the 'largest building in world' - in Chengdu's Tianfu district (a new hub for finance, IT and biochemical industries), in China. The New Century Global Centre is big enough to house 20 Sydney Opera Houses and contains an artificial beach boasting the world's largest artificial waves; two 1000 bedroom hotels, a 14 screen IMAX cinema, an artificial sun that will shine 24 hours a day to "allow for a comfortable temperature"; palm trees which blast visitors with a sea breeze intended to "make one intoxicated, as if he were enjoying himself in the fabulous heaven"; a pirate ship; offices; a University complex; an entire faux Mediterranean village; and a huge LED screen on which "the alternating morning cloud and twilight afterglow extend the horizon limitlessly in the temporal and spatial directions". The centre's promotional video describes it as "a world class modern city of idyllic beauty, where recreation has become the core value of modern business concepts and business will become a way of life". Our extension will house additional public toilets.
